

Introduction

This one day meeting aims to provide a forum for young researchers and others working in the field of geoanalysis, to present research in a friendly environment and to network with fellow geoanalysts. The meeting is being organised by the International Association of Geoanalysts (IAG) with sponsorship from the Geochemistry Group of the Mineralogical Society and the Geological Society.

Venue

The Royal Holloway College site at Egham is easily reached by road from the M25 J13, and is well served by a regular train service to Egham Station from Waterloo main line station.

Presentations

There will be provision for both oral and poster presentations although the number of oral presentations will be limited. Speakers should allow 20 min including 5 min for discussion. Abstracts should be sent with registration form and laid out according to the instructions on the reverse of this circular

Prizes

There will be two prizes for the best oral and best poster presentations given by a student. Talks and posters will be judged both on scientific content and quality of the presentation, and prizes will be awarded at the end of the meeting.

Bursaries

A number of student bursaries are available to help with travel to the meeting and, where necessary, to contribute towards overnight accommodation. Students wishing to apply for a bursary should send a 'case for support' including an estimate of costs (maximum 1 page A4) to the meeting organisers with a completed registration form. Deadline for application of bursaries is 30th June 2005.
