ARSF CONDITIONS OF USE

Data from the NERC ARSF are available to registered NEODC users subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Access to all data submitted to the NEODC will be restricted to the ARSF project PI team for one year following the archival data, after which they will be released to any registered user
- 2. No data should be transferred to a third party, unless they have registered at NEODC and agreed to the conditions of use
- 3. In all cases where the data are used in a presentation or publication, an acknowledgement must be given: for example, "Data from the NERC ARSF are provided courtesy of NERC via the NERC Earth Observation Data Centre (NEODC)."
- 4. Information submitted in application for access to the data will be made available to: The Natural Environment Research Council (NERC) and its delegated authorities, i.e. the NERC Earth Observation Data Centre and the British Atmospheric Data Centre (BADC) and their host organisation, the Science and Technology Facilities Council (STFC) for the purposes of tracking data usage and of improving the service.
