

ECMWF ERA Products – Conditions of Use

The ECMWF products ERA-Interim, ERA-40, ERA-15, ERA-CLIM and ERA-CLIM2 are hereinafter referred collectively as "ECMWF ERA Products".

1. Users can use the ECMWF ERA Products for their own purposes including:

- Research purposes
- Educational purposes
- Commercial purposes, including the provision of services

2. Users cannot use the ECMWF ERA Products to:

- Distribute, sell or licence them in the form the users receive them to any third party as part of their activities.
- If users provide services based on the ECMWF ERA Products, the recipients of the derivative works and services must not be able to retrieve the original ECMWF ERA Products from them.
- If users would like to redistribute ECMWF ERA Products, they must seek prior written permission from ECMWF as this is not covered by the licence.

3. Users undertake to:

- Store the ECMWF ERA Products in a safe place to avoid access by unauthorised persons.
- Notify ECMWF if they become aware of any unauthorised use of or access to ECMWF ERA Products.
- Acknowledge that ECMWF and its licensors are the sole proprietors of all intellectual property rights on the ECMWF ERA Products.
- Acknowledge ECMWF in any scientific publication using the ECMWF ERA Products (or derivatives) and provide a copy of such publication to ECMWF upon request.

4. ECMWF does not warrant that:

- The ECMWF ERA Products will be complete and accurate. If users use them, it is at their own risk.
- Any software provided to access the ECMWF ERA Products will be error-free. If users use such software, it is at their own risk.
- Access to the ECMWF ERA Products will be always available. Access to the ECMWF ERA Products may become temporarily unavailable or for indefinite periods.

5. ECMWF reserves the right to:

- Terminate a licence to access and use ECMWF ERA Products if users are in violation of the licence terms.
- Change the terms of the licence agreement.
- Add, remove, modify or otherwise alter the ECMWF ERA Products without notice.
